Great Straight Line Quilting – Saturday, April 3rd 10am-1pm, Tuition: \$30

You've layered your quilt. Now what? Straight line quilting can be fun and give your quilt great texture. Learn the latest tips and how to use some fun tools to help keep those lines as straight as possible.

Stipling and Nothing But Stipling – Saturday, May 1st 10am-1pm, Tuition: \$30

It's easier than it looks, but takes practice. Learn how to make the free motion quilting stitch that resembles puzzle pieces. You'll make many samples in class as we work through this fun technique.

Free Motion Shapes – Saturday, June 5th 10am-1pm, Tuition: \$30

Get more comfortable with hand guided quilting. Drop those feed dogs and join us for a fun session devoted to spirals, flowers, text and more.

Binding Basics – Saturday, July 3rd 10am-1pm, Tuition: \$30

In this class, you'll learn how to do a tradition mitered corner binding. You'll also explore some other fast binding techniques that will add a little fun to your quilt project.

Rod Pockets & Hanging Your Quilts – Saturday, Sept. 25th 10am-1pm, Tuition: \$30

The quilting is complete and the binding finished. Now how do you hang it? Learn the traditional techniques of attaching a rod pocket and some wonderful non-traditional ways to hang your quilt.

HEIRLOOM SEWING

Learn basic and intermediate heirloom techniques as you create a sampler which you can reference any time you wish to create an heirloom garment.
